5. A family of two adults and one senior is trying to decide whether they should visit Hershey Park or Great Wolf Lodge. Give them the prices for both parks and then make your recommendation.
6. A family of two seniors, one adult, and three children ages 1, 5, and 7 are deciding between Universal Studios Japan, Legoland, and Splash Country. They want to go to TWO of the three parks over summer break. Work out the prices for them and give them the two options that will be the cheapest ticket costs (do not include travel expenses).
7. A couple is planning their honeymoon! They want to know if it would be cheaper to go to Disneyworld for two days OR go Six Flags Magic Mountain for a day then to Sea World for a day. Give them the prices and make your recommendations.
8. One adult and two children want to go to either Sanrio Harmonyland or Nickelodeon Universe. Which would be cheaper tickets for them?
